# The Stag Brewery

Our Brewery was established in 2016 and within 6 months we had won CAMRA's 'pub of the season' award. We have been represented at several local beer festivals and continue to look to grow and expand our range. Tom Haddock is our brewer, capably supported by John.

On the bar you will generally find our House Beer – Stag Ale along with one other from our range. To make our beers we use malt, hops, water and yeast. There are no preservatives and carbon dioxide is not used to extend the life of our beer.

**Stag Ale 3.9% abv** Pint  
£3.10

Stag Ale is our house beer, available all the time.

Stag ale is a golden ale made predominately with cascade hops.

It has a well rounded taste, with a bitter citrus finish.

**IPA 4.5% abv** £3.10

Our IPA is a traditional, strong Indian Ale. It is a single hopped beer made fully with Golding hops. The high alcohol content is balanced by the traditional understated IPA flavour.

**Bridgewater Ale 4.1% abv** £3.10

Named for the Bridgewater Canal, this ale is single hopped with Bravo hops. It is a deep powerful beer with a mix of citrus and spice flavours.

**The Bridge 4.1% abv** £3.10

Named for the 790 tonnes of steel which is our closest neighbour, The Bridge combines traditional Golding hops with Slovenian Savjinski hops. This is our only beer which has a late secondary hop addition giving it a hoppy punchy flavour.

**The Wire 3.7% abv** £3.10

The Wire is a traditional northern pale ale balancing Golding and bravo hops, for a rounded flavour but long finish in the mouth.

Classically made and very elegant, this quality Champagne is rich and full-bodied with rich fruit flavours, a lively mousse and fresh balanced finish.

### **Pol Roger NV Brut, France**

A beautifully golden straw yellow Champagne with the fine, persistent bubbles. On the nose, the Champagne is dominated by white flowers, green apple, brioche and a trace of minerality. On the palate there are notes of stone fruits, a certain nuttiness and a hint of honey supporting the freshness of the acidity.

<b>Plymouth Gin</b> Distilled since 1793 with six different herbs and Dartmore Water.	£3.20

**Speyside:** More than half of all Scottish distilleries are on Speyside. Generally sweeter and richer than other malts.
